EVENT REPORT

National Mass Deworming Program

Deworming improves health outcomes- well-being, reduces risk of anemia and improves nutrition, height & weight. Improves learning ability cognitive functions and school attendance. It targets one of the most common, long-term Soil Transmitted Helminthes (STH) infections of children

Mass De-worming Programme is a simple, safe and cost-effective to improve the health and wellbeing of children.

As per the directive from **Directorate General of Health Services, Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi, Directorate of Education**, the Child Health Division, MoHFW, Govt. of India, the **DE-WORMING PROGRAMME** should be executed in Delhi every year in two phases

The school conducted the first phase of School based Biannual National Mass De-worming programme on April 12-13, 2022. All student from Nursery to class XII, were administered a single dose of chewable Tab. "**Albendazole 400 mg** ", as guided.

The execution of the program was done at a mass scale by Nurse Karishma under the guidance of the school Doctor Dr. Anuradha Arora who administered the students of classes Nursery and IX. Special instructions were given to the students regarding any complication. They were observed for half an hour. No complications were reported during and post the programme.
