### EVENT REPORT

As part of International School Award initiated by the British Council on the topic **FABRICS TO UNITE**, G.D.GOENKA PUBLIC SCHOOL organized a visit to a fabric store “HP Singh” in Nehru Place on 27.07.2019. This was to give the students a first-hand experience of a fabric store visit and to enable them to correlate the different types of fabrics available in India and New Zealand in different seasons.

The various **Types and Sources** of various fabrics were explained to the students for e.g. **Natural Fabrics and Man-made Fabrics** like silk, cotton, nylon, velvet etc. Sources of both, were discussed in detail with information on how Silk is generated from silkworms, the process of wool from sheep, Cotton from cotton plant, Linen from flax plant and so on. Also **Man Made Fabrics** like Viscose from Pine trees/Petrochemicals, Nylon and Polyester from oil and coal etc. The students were also told about various other fabrics like Satin, Rayon, and Khadi etc. The store Manager demonstrated various textures and prints as well.

It was a new learning experience for Goenkans who collected various swatches of fabrics as takeaways for their project.
