EVENT REPORT

Good eyesight is critical to any child's success in school. Since most learning is done through eyes, it is important that students have a regular eye check-up.

Vision check-up was conducted at G.D. Goenka Public School, Sarita Vihar, for all students of classes Nursery to VIII. The check-up was conducted over a period of 9 days, Wednesday, January 18, 2017 to Tuesday, January 31, 2017, devoting each day to a batch of two classes. Far vision and near vision was checked for every students by the School Doctor and School Nurse. Snellen chart, near-vision booklet and colour vision booklet were used to test visual acuity. Pictorial charts were shown to Nursery students. In the process, some students were detected with low eye vision (myopia), hence were advised reference to an ophthalmologist for further evaluation and correction with spectacles.
